As scouts and parents age out, we need to rotate in new volunteers. Following are brief summary for Troop volunteer needs:

- OUTING/ACTIVITY COORDINATOR(S) – For any activity to occur, it will need a coordinator *other than the scoutmaster* to work with the PLC and other adult leadership. Coordinator will meet with PLC to help them develop location of activity, budget, potential advancement and other details. Coordinator will develop activity form, collect fees, make travel arrangements and ideally attend outing. (1 time minimum). Troop has archived forms for use, Brad and others can be resource.
- POPCORN KERNEL - coordinate popcorn sales and collections. (1 month commitment in fall)
- CAMP CARD - coordinator sales and collections. (1 month commitment in spring)
- SERVICE COORDINATOR - find and coordinate potential service activities for scouts (intermittent through the year)
